**REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO**

**Act No. 10 of 1984**

**AN ACT** to provide for the payment of a gratuity and reduced pension to the personal representatives of Claude Boyce (deceased), former Valuation Clerk of the San Fernando Borough Council, and matters relating thereto.

*[Assented to 12th April, 1984]*

**ENACTED** by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment  
follows:—

**1.** This Act may be cited as the Claude Boyce Short title  
(Pension and Gratuity) Act, 1984.

**2.** For the purposes of section 17 of the Municipal Corporations (Pensions) Act, Claude Boyce (now deceased), a former Valuation Clerk of the San Fernando Borough Council, who retired at age fifty-seven on the 4th January, 1982 and died on the 9th March, 1982 is deemed to have exercised his option to receive a gratuity and a reduced pension in accordance with the requirements of that section.
