**AN ACT to provide that Nydia Bernard and Sylvia
Herrera, former members of the Teaching Service,
be accorded trained teacher status.**

[Assented to 18th June, 1985]

**1. This Act may be cited as the Bernard and Herrera Short title
(Trained Teacher Status) Act, 1985.**

Status
upgraded

2. Nydia Bernard and Sylvia Herrera former members of the Teaching Service are deemed to have been accorded trained teacher status that is to say to have been appointed Education Officer Grade I (Trained) with effect from 1st January, 1961 and 1st January, 1960 respectively.

Pension
and
gratuity
payable

3. Superannuation benefits payable to Nydia Bernard and Sylvia Herrera shall be computed on the basis of their having retired from the Teaching Service as Education Officer I (Trained) but any pension or gratuity already paid to Nydia Bernard or Sylvia Herrera shall be taken into account in making the final payment of pension and gratuity payable by reason of this Act.
