REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

**Act No. 21 of 1998**

[L.S.]

AN ACT to supplement and vary the appropriation of the sum the issue of which was authorized by the Appropriation Act, 1998.

*[Assented to August 28, 1998]*

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as <sup>Enactment</sup> follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Finance <sup>Short title</sup> (Supplementation and Variation of Appropriation) (1998) Act, 1998.

Construction of  
Act No. 2 of 1998

2. In this Act and in any other written law, a reference to the Appropriation Act, 1998, shall be construed as a reference to that Act as for the time being varied or otherwise amended by any Finance (Variation of Appropriation) Act, passed before this or that other written law.

Further issue from  
the Consolidated  
Fund

3. A further issue from the Consolidated Fund in the sum of thirty-five million dollars is authorized for meeting expenditure for the service of the year ending 31st December, 1998, and appropriated in respect of the following Head indicated in the Schedule to the Appropriation Act, 1998, entitled:

42—Ministry of Local Government

Increase in Heads of  
Expenditure  
Schedule

4. The sums appropriated to the Heads of Expenditure specified in the First Column of Part I of the Schedule by the Appropriation Act, 1998, are increased by the amounts specified in the Second Column of that Part.

Reduction in Heads  
of Expenditure

5. The sums appropriated to the Heads of Expenditure specified in the First Column of Part II of the Schedule by the Appropriation Act, 1998, are reduced by the amounts specified in the Second Column of that Part.

Sums appropriated  
in respect of Heads  
specified in Part II  
may be utilised

6. The sums appropriated in respect of the Heads of Expenditure specified in the First Column of Part II of the Schedule by the Appropriation Act 1998, and unissued at the commencement of this Act may be utilised, notwithstanding anything contained in the Exchequer and Audit Act, for the discharge of any liability incurred by reason of the increase in the expenditure in respect of the Heads of Expenditure specified in Part I of the Schedule.
