TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

Act No. 40 of 1966

AN ACT to vary the sums appropriated to Heads of Expenditure set out in the Appropriation Act, 1966.

[Assented to 22nd December, 1966]

BE IT ENACTED by The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, Enactment by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Finance (Variation of Short title Appropriations) (No. 4) Act, 1966.

Interpretation

2. In this Act, the expression "the Appropriation Act, 1966" means the Appropriation Act, 1966, as varied from time to time by the Finance (Variation of Appropriations) Act, 1966, the Finance (Variation of Appropriations) (No. 2) Act, 1966, and the Finance (Variation of Appropriations) (No. 3) Act, 1966.

Increase in certain Heads of expenditure

3. The sums appropriated to the several Heads of Expenditure set out in the First Column of Part I of the Schedule by the Appropriation Act, 1966, are hereby increased by the amounts specified in the second column of the said Part.

Reductions in certain Heads of Expenditure

4. The sums appropriated to the several Heads of Expenditure set out in the First Column of Part II of the Schedule by the Appropriation Act, 1966, are hereby reduced by the amounts specified in the second column of the said Part.

Sums appropriated in respect of Heads set out in Part II may be utilized

5. Notwithstanding anything contained in the Exchequer and Audit Ordinance, 1959, the sums appropriated in respect of the Heads of Expenditure set out in the First Column of Part II of the Schedule by the Appropriation Act, 1966, and unissued at the commencement of this Act may be utilised for the discharge of any liability incurred by reason of the increase of the expenditure in respect of the Heads set out in the First Column of Part I of the Schedule.
