AN ACT to amend the Pensions Extension Ordinance, 1961.

Assented to 4th July, 1967]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, ^{Enactment}
by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and
House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and
by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Pensions Extension ^{Short title}
(Amendment) Act, 1967.

2. The Pensions Extension Ordinance, 1961 is hereby amended—

- (a) by deleting subsection (2) of section 2 thereof and substituting therefor the following:

“(2) A reference in this Ordinance to a statutory board shall be read and construed as a reference to a board, authority, committee or other body specifically named in the Schedule and a reference to an office or a post in relation to a statutory board shall be construed as a reference to an office or a post under any or all of the authorities, committees or other bodies named as aforesaid, as the case may require.”;

- (b) in subsection (2) of section 3 by adding after the words “public service” the words “or under a statutory board”;

- (c) by inserting after section 3 thereof the following:—

3A. (1) A person, other than a depositor to the Provident Fund who has not elected under section 4 to continue to be a depositor to the Provident Fund, who has become the holder of an office that is made a pensionable office by virtue of section 3 and was the holder of such office between the 1st day of January, 1959, and the date of the commencement of this Ordinance, is entitled to count towards pension in accordance with the Pensions Ordinance all his service in that office together with any other continuous service immediately preceding such pensionable service under a statutory board, department of Government or other authority or body specified in an Order made in that behalf by the Governor-General.

(2) Where in pursuance of the provisions of any law other than the Pensions Laws, a Superannuation Scheme is established for the benefit of the holders of offices under a statutory board, the period of pensionable service together with any other service which by virtue of subsection (1) they may be entitled to count towards pension shall be deemed to be service for the purpose of any such Scheme, and the Minister

responsible for Finance shall cause to be paid out of public funds to the credit of such Scheme an amount equal to that which such person would have contributed to that Scheme had he during the period of his pensionable service made contributions in the manner and at the relevant rates prescribed by such Scheme.

(3) In this section "the Pensions Laws" means the Pensions Ordinance and the regulations made thereunder and any enactments amending or replacing the same.;

(d) by adding to the Schedule the following:
