A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS section 238(1) of the Defence Act, Chap. 14:01 provides *inter alia* that the President may call out the Volunteer Defence Force or any portion of it for actual military service with their arms and ammunition, in aid of the civil power in any case in which a riot, disturbance of the peace or other emergency requiring such service occurs or is, in the opinion of the President, anticipated as likely to occur, and in either case to be beyond the powers of the civil authorities to suppress or to prevent or deal with:

And whereas the State deems it necessary to call out to duty, members of the Volunteer Defence Force for a period of eighty-two days with effect from July 11 to September 30, 2003 to assist the regular Force in anti-crime operations being conducted in the Morvant/Laventille area:

Now, therefore, I, GEORGE MAXWELL RICHARDS, President as aforesaid, hereby call out for a period of eighty-two days with effect from July 11, 2003 to September 30, 2003, a complement of two hundred and twenty-five members of the Trinidad and Tobago Volunteer Defence Force for actual military service with their arms and ammunition, in aid of the civil power in the maintenance of peace and public order in Trinidad and Tobago.
