AN ORDINANCE to provide that certain offices shall not be offices of emolument, or paid offices or other places of profit, under the Crown or under the Government of the Colony within the meaning of legislation relating to the Municipalities and County Councils.

[5th November, 1957.]

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Local Government (Removal of Certain Disqualifications) Ordinance, 1957.

(2) This Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 5th day of November, 1957.

2. The offices set out in the Second Column of the Schedule hereto (being offices constituted under the provisions of law respectively set out in the First Column of the said Schedule) other than any office expressed in the said Second Column to be excluded, shall not be—

Certain offices not to be offices of emolument or paid offices under the Crown for certain purposes.

(a) offices of emolument under the Crown or under the Government of the Colony within the meaning of paragraph (c) of subsection (4) of section 13 of the Port-of-Spain Corporation Ordinance, or of paragraph (c) of subsection (2) of section 12 of the San Fernando Corporation Ordinance or of paragraph (c) of subsection (2) of section 12 of the Arima Corporation Ordinance;

(b) paid offices or other places of profit under the Crown or under the Government of the Colony within the meaning of proviso (d) to section 84 of the County Councils Ordinance.

3. (1) The Governor in Council may from time to time by order amend the Schedule hereto by deleting the reference to any office mentioned therein or by including other offices therein or otherwise as he may consider expedient.

Amendment of Schedule.

(2) No such order shall have effect unless it has been approved by resolution of the Legislative Council.

4. A person shall not be deemed to be the holder of—

(a) an office of emolument under the Crown or under the Government of the Colony within the meaning of paragraph (c) of subsection (4) of section 13 of the Port-of-Spain Corporation Ordinance, or of paragraph (c) of subsection (2) of section 12 of the San Fernando Corporation Ordinance or of paragraph (c) of subsection (2) of section 12 of the Arima Corporation Ordinance, or

Travelling or Subsistence Allowances not to constitute office an office of emolument or a paid office under the Crown.

(b) a paid office or other place of profit under the Crown or under the Government of the Colony within the meaning of proviso (d) to section 84 of the County Councils Ordinance,

by reason of holding any office or place in the service or appointment of the Crown or of the Government of the Colony or performing any functions on behalf of the Crown or the

Government of the Colony, being an office or functions in respect of which he receives or is entitled to receive payment by way only of travelling and of subsistence allowances or travelling or subsistence allowances or a refund of out of pocket expenses.
