Enactment

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Cocoa Industry (Amendment) Ordinance, 1954, and shall be read as one with the Cocoa Industry Ordinance, in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. Subsection (2) of section 9 of the Principal Ordinance as enacted by section 2 of the Cocoa Industry (Amendment) Ordinance, 1952-1953 is hereby repealed and replaced by the following:—

“(2) (a) No payment from the Fund shall be made by the Accountant General except on the authority of a voucher signed by an officer of the Board authorised by the Board so to do.

(b) The Board shall notify the Accountant General of the full name of every officer authorised by the Board to sign vouchers for the purposes of paragraph (a) of this subsection, and shall supply the Accountant General with a specimen of the signature of every such officer.

(c) The Board may at any time cancel any authorisation given under paragraph (a) of this subsection and in such event shall immediately notify the Accountant General of such cancellation.”

3. The Cocoa Industry (Amendment) Ordinance, 1952-1953 is hereby repealed.
