AN ORDINANCE to make special provision for the grant of gratuities and pensions to certain Government employees.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Enactment

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Government Employees (Gratuities and Pensions) Ordinance, 1951.

Short title

Authority to pay gratuities and reduced pensions to certain Government employees

Ch. 9, No. 6

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in any law relating to the grant of pensions, there may be paid from general revenue to the persons named in the first column of the Schedule to this Ordinance, being Government employees holding offices described in the second column of the said Schedule, on their retirement from the service of the Colony, gratuities and reduced pensions in respect of their services in such offices computed as though such offices had been declared pensionable offices within the meaning of the Pensions Ordinance with effect from the date specified in the third column of the said Schedule:

Provided that the Governor in Council may vary the said Schedule by adding thereto the name of any other Government employee.
