AN ORDINANCE to amend the Mount Saint Benedict  
Monastery Incorporation Ordinance, 1927.— 21/71

**E**NACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof. Enactment.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Mount Saint Benedict Monastery Incorporation (Amendment) Ordinance, 1949, and shall be read as one with the Mount Saint Benedict Monastery Incorporation Ordinance, 1927, hereinafter called the Principal Ordinance. Short title

2. The following new section is hereby inserted in the Principal Ordinance immediately after section 4 thereof and shall form part of the said Ordinance :

“Power to  
borrow money  
and give  
mortgages,  
&c.

4A. It shall also be lawful for the Incorporated Trustees, subject to such rules, regulations and control as aforesaid, from time to time to borrow money, and, for the repayment of the same, by deed under their seal to give and execute mortgages, charges, pledges or other securities of their real or personal property or to make any such arrangements as they may consider expedient, with such covenants, powers and provisions as they may think proper”.

Passed in Council this thirteenth day of May, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and forty-nine.
