1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Judicature (Amend- Short title
ment) Ordinance, 1954, and shall be read as one with the

2. Section 18 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed and replaced by the following:—

“18. The Deputy Registrar shall be Deputy Marshal of the Court at Port-of-Spain, and the senior Principal Officer in the Registry of the Court shall be the Second Deputy Marshal of the Court at Port-of-Spain. The Sub-Registrars shall be the Deputy Marshals of the Courts at San Fernando and Tobago respectively, and the Governor shall appoint an officer in the Registry of the Court to be Second Deputy Marshal of the Court at San Fernando. The Deputy Marshals and Second Deputy Marshals shall, subject to rules of Court, have all the powers and may perform all the duties of the Marshal.”
