AN ACT to amend the Conveyancing and Law of
Property Ordinance, Ch. 27. No. 12

[Assented to 13th October, 2000]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment
follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Conveyancing and Short title
Law of Property (Amendment) Act, 2000.

Section 5 amended

2. The Conveyancing and Law of Property Ordinance is amended by repealing section 5 and substituting the following section:

“Statutory
commence-
ment

5. In the completion of any contract of sale of land after the commencement of the Conveyancing and Law of Property (Amendment) Act, 2000 and subject to any stipulation to the contrary in the contract, twenty years shall be the period of commencement of the title which a purchaser may require.”.
