| Citation | 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Defence (Pensions, Terminal and Other Grants) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations, 1969. |
| Regulations amended | <p>2. The Defence (Pensions, Terminal and Other Grants) Regulations, 1968, is amended by deleting regulation 3 (3) thereof and by substituting therefor the following new regulation 3 (3):</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">“(3) Notwithstanding that he has attained the age at which he is required by the provisions of this regulation to retire, an officer or other rank who on the 31st day of December, 1967, had attained the age of thirty-five years and who on that day was a member of the Force may, on the recommendation of his Commanding Officer, be permitted by the Minister to continue his colour service for such period not exceeding eight years as the Minister in his discretion may determine; and any such service shall be counted as pensionable service for the purpose of these Regulations.”</p> |
