THE DEFENCE (PENSIONS, TERMINAL AND OTHER GRANTS)
(AMENDMENT) (No. 3) REGULATIONS, 1969

1. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Defence (Terminal and Other Grants) (Amendment) (No. 3) Regulations, 1969. Citation
(2) These Regulations have effect from the 1st day of January, 1966.
2. In these Regulations a reference to the Pensions Regulations shall be read as a reference to the Defence (Pensions, Terminal and Other Grants) Regulations, 1968. Definition

3. Regulation 2 of the Pensions Regulations is amended as follows:— Regulation 2
of Pensions
Regulations
amended
 - (a) in paragraph (e) thereof by adding at the end thereof the following
“and includes paid colour service in Her Majesty’s Military Forces, or in the West India Regiment;”;
 - (b) by inserting immediately after the definition of “child” occurring therein the following new definition:
(dd) “Her Majesty’s Military Service” includes any Commonwealth Force.
4. Regulation 18 of the Pensions Regulations is amended as follows:— Regulation 18
amended
 - (a) by inserting after the words “qualifying service” occurring therein, the words “as well as pensionable service”;
 - (b) by substituting for the words “in the Defence Force” occurring therein the words “as well as his pensionable service in.”
5. The Defence (Pensions, Terminal and Other Grants) (Amendment) Regulations, 1969 are hereby revoked.
