MADE BY THE MINISTER UNDER SECTION 233 OF THE DEFENCE ACT, 1962

THE DEFENCE (PENSIONS, TERMINAL AND OTHER GRANTS)
(AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1976

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Defence (Pensions, Terminal and Other Grants) (Amendment) Regulations, 1976. Citation

2. Regulation 3 of the Defence (Pensions, Terminal and Other Grants) Regulations, 1968, is amended by repealing subparagraph (b) of paragraph (3) thereof and replacing it as follows: — Regulation 3

“(b) an officer who is a brigadier may be permitted by the President to continue his colour service for such period not exceeding five years as the President in his discretion may determine; provided however that in exceptional circumstances such officer may be further permitted by the President to continue his colour service for a period not exceeding six months at any one time and not exceeding in the aggregate two years; and all such colour service shall, unless it is governed by a contract in writing that provides otherwise, be counted as pensionable service for the purposes of the Regulations.”

3. These Regulations shall be deemed to have come into force on the 3rd day of September, 1976. Commence-
