REGULATIONS

MADE BY THE MINISTER OF NATIONAL SECURITY UNDER SECTION 244  
OF THE DEFENCE ACT

THE DEFENCE (RATES OF PAY AND ALLOWANCES)  
(AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1995

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Defence (Rates of Pay Citation and Allowances) (Amendment) Regulations, 1995.

2. The Defence (Rates of Pay and Allowances) Regulations, 1989<sup>No. 64 of 1989</sup> are amended by deleting regulation 16(1) and substituting the<sup>amended</sup> following:

“ (1) A member of the Force who is in a country other than Trinidad and Tobago, for the purpose of being attached to, serving with or attending a course with Forces of that other country, is entitled to—

- (a) the rate of pay he receives in his rank and according to his service in Trinidad and Tobago;
- (b) his other allowances unless these other allowances are being paid directly to the relevant authority in that other country by the Government of Trinidad and Tobago; and
- (c) for the purpose of engaging in peace-keeping or combat operations, a Special Duty Allowance at the rate of five hundred dollars a month.”
