A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS section 238(1) of the Defence Act, Chap. 14:01 provides *inter alia* that the President may call out the Volunteer Defence Force or any portion of it for actual military service with their arms and ammunition, in aid of the civil power in any case in which a riot, disturbance of the peace, or other emergency requiring such service occurs, or is, in the opinion of the President, anticipated as likely to occur, and in either case to be beyond the powers of the civil authorities to suppress, or to prevent:

And whereas it has come to the knowledge of the State that there is likely to be attempted a disturbance of the peace in relation to the murder trial being conducted at the Fourth Assize Court, Chaguaramas (Indictment No. 47 of 1995), which disturbance, in the opinion of the President, is likely to be beyond the powers of the civil authorities to suppress or prevent:

Now, therefore, I, NOOR MOHAMED HASSANALI, President as aforesaid, hereby call out for a period of thirty days commencing June 17, 1996 a complement of one hundred and eighty members of the Trinidad and Tobago Volunteer Defence Force for actual military service with their arms and ammunition, in aid of the civil power in the maintenance of peace and public order in Trinidad and Tobago.
