REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

REGULATIONS

MADE BY THE MINISTER UNDER SECTION 244 OF THE
DEFENCE ACT

THE DEFENCE (RATES OF PAY AND ALLOWANCES)
(AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1997

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Defence (Rates of Pay and Allowances) (Amendment) Regulations, 1997. Citation

2. The Defence (Rates of Pay and Allowances) Regulations, 1989 are amended by— L.N. 84 of 1989 amended

(a) deleting regulation 9, and by substituting the following regulation:

“Loans for the purchase of a motor vehicle and motor vehicle insurance
Chap. 1:01

9. (1) The Chief of Defence Staff, may be granted such loans for the purchase of a motor vehicle and motor vehicle insurance as the Salaries Review Commission established by section 140 of the Constitution of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago may recommend.

(2) Subregulation (1), is deemed to have come into effect on March 7, 1980.

(3) The Comptroller of Accounts may grant loans in respect of the purchase of a standard grade motor vehicle and the purchase of motor vehicle insurance to the—

- (a) Vice-Chief of Defence Staff;
- (b) Commanding Officer of the Regiment;
and
- (c) Commanding Officer of the Coast Guard,

and the terms of any loan granted under this subregulation, shall be similar to those granted to officers whose posts are scheduled under the Travelling Regulations.

(4) The officers referred to at subregulation (3), are entitled to a commuted travelling allowance at the same rates that are applicable to officers in the Public Service.

(5) Subregulations (3) and (4), are deemed to have applied to the position of Vice-Chief of Defence Staff, with effect from February 3, 1994.”.

(b) deleting regulation 23, and substituting the following regulation:

“Entertain-
ment
allowances

23. (1) The Chief of Defence Staff may be granted such an entertainment allowance as the Salaries Review Commission may recommend.

(2) The Vice-Chief of Defence Staff and the Commanding Officers of the Regiment and Coast Guard are entitled to an entertainment allowance at the rates set out in Part II of the Schedule.

(3) Subregulation (2), is deemed to have applied to the Vice-Chief of Defence Staff with effect from February 3, 1994.”.

(c) deleting the term “Chief of Defence Staff” wherever it occurs in Part II of the Schedule and substituting for it the term “Vice-Chief of Defence Staff”.
