A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS section 238(1) of the Defence Act, Chap. 14:01 provides *inter alia* that the President may call out the Volunteer Defence Force or any portion of it for actual military service with their arms and ammunition, in aid of the civil power in any case in which a riot, disturbance of the peace or other emergency requiring such service occurs or is, in the opinion of the President, anticipated as likely to occur, and in either case to be beyond the powers of the civil authorities to suppress or to prevent or deal with:

And whereas the State deems it necessary to call out to duty members of the Volunteer Defence Force for a period of one week with effect from February 20, 1998 to assist the Regular Forces in the maintenance of peace and public order for the 1998 Carnival Season:

Now, therefore, I, GANACE RAMDIAL, Acting President as aforesaid, hereby call out for a period of one week commencing February 20, 1998 a complement of two hundred and thirty-five members of the Trinidad and Tobago Volunteer Defence Force for actual military service with their arms and ammunition, in aid of the civil power in the maintenance of peace and public order in Trinidad and Tobago.
