A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS section 238(1) of the Defence Act, Chap. 14:01 provides *inter alia* that the President may call out the Volunteer Defence Force or any portion of it for actual military service with their arms and ammunition, in aid of the civil power in any case in which a riot, disturbance of the peace or other emergency requiring such service occurs or is, in the opinion of the President, anticipated as likely to occur, and in either case to be beyond the powers of the civil authorities to suppress or to prevent or deal with:

And whereas the State deems it necessary to call out to duty, members of the Volunteer Defence Force for a period of forty-five days with effect from March 20, 1998 to assist the Regular Force in support of Operation Leap and operations arising from security concerns surrounding the State Land at No. 1 Mucurapo Road, St. James:

Now, therefore, I, GANACE RAMDIAL, Acting President as aforesaid, hereby call out for a period of forty-five days commencing March 20, 1998 a complement of sixty members of the Trinidad and Tobago Volunteer Defence Force for actual military service with their arms and ammunition, in aid of the civil power in the maintenance of peace and public order in Trinidad and Tobago.
