THE DEFENCE (RECIPROCAL TRAINING AND JUNGLE
WARFARE EXERCISES) (REQUISITION OF LANDS)
(NO. 4) ORDER, 2002

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Reciprocal Training and
Jungle Warfare Exercises) (Requisition of Lands) (No. 4) Order, 2002. ^{Citation}

2. The lands described in the Schedule are requisitioned for the ^{Requisition}
period 15th June, 2002 to 29th June, 2002, for the purpose of the ^{of lands}
training, exercises and manoeuvres of the Trinidad and Tobago Defence ^{Schedule}
Force in pursuance of the reciprocal training exercises between the
United States Army South of the United States and the Trinidad and
Tobago Defence Force, scheduled to take place from 15th June, 2002 to
29th June, 2002.

SCHEDULE

(Clause 2)

The requisitioned area shall comprise State lands bounded as follows:

- (a) on the north, by a line commencing from Entrada Point (61° 40' 22" Longitude, 10° 42' 34" Latitude) and running in a north-easterly direction to Morne Jean (61° 35' 10" Longitude, 10° 43' 45" Latitude);
- (b) on the east, by a line commencing from Morne Jean (61° 35' 10" Longitude, 10° 43' 45" Latitude) and running in a southerly direction to Morne Distree (61° 35' 10" Longitude, 10° 42' 25" Latitude);
- (c) on the south, by a line commencing from Morne Distree (61° 35' 10" Longitude, 10° 42' 25" Latitude) and running in a south-westerly direction to Teteron Bay (61° 39' 26" Longitude, 10° 41' 04" Latitude); and
- (d) on the west, by a line commencing from Teteron Bay (61° 39' 26" Longitude, 10° 41' 04" Latitude) and running in a north-westerly direction to Entrada Point (61° 40' 22" Longitude, 10° 42' 34" Latitude).
