REGULATIONS

MADE BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL UNDER SECTION 35 OF
THE CENTRAL TENDERS BOARD ORDINANCE, 1961

THE CENTRAL TENDERS BOARD (AMENDMENT)
REGULATIONS, 1968

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Central Tenders Board (Amendment) Regulations, 1968.

2. Regulation 12 of the Central Tenders Board Regulations, 1965, is hereby amended—

(a) by inserting the words "and Social Welfare" immediately after the words "Local Government" occurring in line two of paragraph

2 (b) thereof;

- (b) by substituting the words "two thousand dollars" for the words "five hundred dollars" occurring in paragraph (3) thereof;
- (c) by inserting immediately after paragraph (3) thereof, the following paragraph:—

"(3) (a) A special ministerial committee established by paragraph (2) (b) may without inviting tenders purchase articles or approve payment for the performance of services as and when required, the total cost of which does not in either case exceed two thousand dollars."

THE RENT RESTRICTION ORDINANCE, CH. 27. No. 18

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS it is provided by subsection (2) of section 1 of the Rent Restriction Ordinance, Ch. 27. No. 18, that the said Ordinance may be continued in force for a further period of twelve months at a time by resolution of the House of Representatives and the Senate:

THE RENT RESTRICTION ORDINANCE, CH. 27. No. 18

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS by subsection (1) of section 4 of the Rent Restriction Ordinance, Ch. 27. No. 18, it is provided *inter alia* that the Governor-General may, if he thinks fit, by order approved by resolution of the House of Representatives and the Senate and published in the *Gazette* exclude from the operation of the Ordinance any specified premises, or any specified classes or descriptions of premises, or any specified classes or description of premises in a specified area:

AND WHEREAS in exercise of the power conferred on him by the said subsection the Governor-General has made the Rent Restriction (Exclusion of Premises) Order, 1968.

Be it Resolved:

That this House approve the Rent Restriction (Exclusion of Premises) Order, 1968.

MADE BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL UNDER SECTION 4 (1) (d) OF
THE RENT RESTRICTION ORDINANCE

THE RENT RESTRICTION (EXCLUSION OF PREMISES)
ORDER, 1968

1. This Order may be cited as the Rent Restriction (Exclusion of Citation Premises) Order, 1968.

2. In this Order—

“the appointed date” means the date on which this Order comes into
operation;

“the Ordinance” means the Rent Restriction Ordinance.

3. There shall be excluded from the operation of the Ordinance with effect from the dates respectively specified in paragraph 4 in relation thereto the following classes of premises—

- (a) all dwelling houses erected before the 12th day of February, 1954, which on the appointed date are in actual occupation of the owner thereof;
- (b) all dwelling houses, the standard rent of which on the appointed date is or exceeds the rate of four hundred and eighty dollars per annum;
- (c) all public and commercial buildings, the standard rent of which on the appointed date is or exceeds the rate of nine hundred dollars per annum.

4. The provisions of paragraph 3 shall have effect—

- (a) in relation to the class of premises described in subparagraph (a) thereof, on the appointed date;
- (b) in relation to the class of premises described in subparagraphs (b) and (c) thereof, on the 12th June, 1969.
