AN ORDINANCE to amend the Customs Ordinance,
Ch. 32. No. 2.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Short Title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Customs (Amendment) Ordinance, 1948, and shall be read as one with the Customs Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

Ch. 32. No. 2

2. Section 75 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by adding the expression "and 7 o'clock in the morning and noon on Saturdays" immediately after the words "four o'clock in the afternoon" appearing in paragraph (b). Section 75 of Principal Ordinance amended.

3. Section 90 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by adding the words "or Saturday after noon" immediately after the words "public holiday" appearing in paragraph (b). Section 90 of Principal Ordinance amended.

4. Section 140 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by adding the words "or Saturdays after noon" immediately after the words "public holidays". Section 140 of Principal Ordinance amended.

5. Section 174 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by adding the words "or Saturdays after noon" immediately after the words "public holidays". Section 174 of Principal Ordinance amended.
