AN ORDINANCE to amend the Customs Ordinance,
Ch. 32. No. 2.

Commencement

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Enactment

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Customs (Amendment) Ordinance, 1954, and shall be read as one with the Customs Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. Section 39 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by substituting for paragraph (1) thereof the following:—

“(1) indecent or obscene prints, paintings, photographs, books, cards, lithographic or other engravings, gramophone records, or any other indecent or obscene articles or matter;”
