AN ACT to amend the Customs Ordinance, Ch. 32. No. 2
[Assented to 18th March, 1969]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by **Enactment**
and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House
of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the
authority of the same, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Customs (Amendment) **Short title**
Act, 1969.

Section 49A
of Ordinance
amended

2. The Customs Ordinance is hereby amended by repealing and replacing subsections (2) and (3) of section 49A with the following:

“(2) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (1), an exemption provided for by any resolution under this section—

(a) may be complete or partial, as the Minister may in his discretion determine; and

(b) shall be operative only in favour of a person who holds a licence issued to him under the provisions of subsection (3).

(3) The Minister may on application made to him in writing in his discretion issue to any person a licence entitling such person to the benefit of an exemption provided for by any resolution under this section and any such licence shall specify the extent of the exemption, the period during which and the conditions subject to which the licensee shall be entitled to such benefits.”.
