THE DEFENCE (RECIPROCAL TRAINING EXERCISES)
(FRENCH MILITARY FORCES) (REQUISITION OF LANDS)
ORDER, 1996

1. This Order may be cited as the the Defence (Reciprocal Training ^{Citation} Exercises) (French Military Forces) (Requisition of Lands) Order, 1996.

2. The lands described in the Schedule are requisitioned for the ^{Requisition} purpose of the training, exercises and manoeuvres of the Force in ^{of lands} pursuance of the Reciprocal Training Exercises between the French Military Forces and the Trinidad and Tobago Defence Force, scheduled ^{Schedule} for the period ending September 20, 1996.

SCHEDULE

(Paragraph 2)

The requisitioned area shall comprise State Lands within the following boundaries:

On the North by a line commencing from Entrada Point (61° 40' 22" Longitude, 10° 42' 34" Latitude) and running in a northeasterly direction to Morne Jean (61° 35' 10" Longitude, 10° 43' 45" Latitude);

On the East by a line commencing from Morne Jean (61° 35' 10" Longitude, 10° 43' 45" Latitude) and running in a southerly direction to Morne Distree (61° 35' 10" Longitude, 10° 42' 25" Latitude);

On the South by a line commencing from Morne Distree (61° 35' 10" Longitude, 10° 42' 25" Latitude) and running in a southwesterly direction to Teteron Bay (61° 39' 26" Longitude, 10° 41' 04" Latitude); and

On the West by a line commencing from Teteron Bay (61° 39' 26" Longitude, 10° 41' 04" Latitude) and running in a northwesterly direction to Entrada Point (61° 40' 22" Longitude, 10° 42' 34" Latitude).
