MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)  
(ONE HUNDRED AND TWELFTH ANNIVERSARY OF THE  
RESTORATION OF CIVIC AND MUNICIPAL RIGHTS TO  
THE CITY OF PORT-OF-SPAIN) ORDER, 2026

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Provisions) (One Hundred and Twelfth Anniversary of the Restoration of Civic and Municipal Rights to the City of Port-of-Spain) Order, 2026. Citation

2. This Order has effect between the hours of 3.00 a.m. and 2.00 p.m. on Wednesday 24th June, 2026. Duration

3. Parking of a motor vehicle is prohibited on the following roads: Parking prohibited

- (a) Queen's Park West, between Queen's Park East and Chancery Lane;
- (b) Chancery Lane, between Gordon Street and Queen's Park West;
- (c) Keate Street;
- (d) Frederick Street, between Queen's Park West and Independence Square North;
- (e) Knox Street, between Pembroke Street and Frederick Street;
- (f) Hart Street;
- (g) Queen Street, between Frederick Street and Henry Street;
- (h) Independence Square North, between Frederick Street and Henry Street;
- (i) Frederick Street, between Independence Square North and Hart Street;
- (j) Henry Street, between Independence Square North and Prince Street;
- (k) Pembroke Street, between Knox Street and Duke Street; and
- (l) Prince Street, between Frederick Street and Henry Street.

- Vehicular traffic prohibited
4. Vehicular traffic is prohibited between 9.30 a.m. and 1.00 p.m. on the following roads:
- (a) Frederick Street, between Queen’s Park West and Independence Square South;
  - (b) Pembroke Street, between Gordon Street and Keate Street;
  - (c) Keate Street, between Charlotte Street and Abercromby Street;
  - (d) Knox Street, between Pembroke Street and Frederick Street;
  - (e) Hart Street, between Frederick Street and Independence Square North;
  - (f) Independence Square North between Henry Street and Frederick Street; and
  - (g) Queen Street, between Frederick Street and Henry Street.
- Taxi stand
5. A taxi driver plying—
- (a) the St. Ann’s route from Hart Street, shall operate from the southern side of Independence Square North, between Edward Street and St. Vincent Street;
  - (b) the St. James route from Hart Street, shall operate from the southern side of Independence Square South, between Edward Street and St. Vincent Street; and
  - (c) the Ice House/Broadway/Marine Square route, shall operate from the northern side of Independence Square South, between St. Vincent Street and Edward Street.
- Removal of vehicles
6. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a traffic violation, a member of the Police Service may, in accordance with section 108 of the Act, remove or cause to be removed a vehicle that is parked in contravention of this Order, or left on any road in such a manner that it is likely to cause an obstruction to persons lawfully using the road.
