THE EMERGENCY POWERS REGULATIONS, 2026

REVOCATION ORDER

MADE BY THE MINISTER OF HOMELAND SECURITY IN ACCORDANCE
WITH PARAGRAPH 9 OF THE SCHEDULE TO THE EMERGENCY POWERS
REGULATIONS, 2026

WHEREAS it is enacted by regulation 14 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that the provisions of the Schedule shall have effect for the purpose of the preventive detention of persons:

And whereas on the 19th day of March, 2026, a detention order was made to detain AKIDO WILLIAMS also called “SUNDAY” of No. 21 Basilon Street, East Dry River, Port-of-Spain, at the Eastern Correctional Rehabilitation Centre, located at Santa Rosa, Arima, or such other place as the Minister may from time to time direct, pursuant to the Schedule to the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026:

And whereas it is provided at paragraph 9 to the Schedule of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that the Minister may revoke a detention order at any time:

Now, therefore, I, the Honourable Roger Alexander, Minister of Homeland Security, in exercise of the powers conferred on me, do hereby revoke the detention order dated the 19th day of March, 2026, made in relation to the said AKIDO WILLIAMS also called “SUNDAY” of No. 21 Basilon Street, East Dry River, Port-of-Spain.
