**AN ACT to provide for the Supplementary Appropriation
for the service of Trinidad and Tobago for the year
ending 31st December, 1993.**

[Assented to 2nd December , 1993]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment
follows:—

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation Act, 1993.

Further sum of
\$475,277,962
from Consolidated
Fund

2. A further issue from the Consolidated Fund of four hundred and seventy-five million, two hundred and seventy-seven thousand, nine hundred and sixty-two dollars is authorised for meeting expenditure for the service of the year ending 31st December, 1993 under the Heads of Expenditure specified in the Schedule; and the sum specified in the Schedule opposite a head of Expenditure is appropriated out of the four hundred and seventy-five million, two hundred and seventy-seven thousand, nine hundred and sixty-two dollars for the purposes specified in relation to that Head in supplementary estimates for the year 1993.
