**REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO**

**Act No. 16 of 1993**

**AN ACT for the Incorporation of the Sri Sathya Sai Baba  
Organisation of Trinidad and Tobago and for  
matters incidental thereto.**

*[Assented to 7th July, 1993]*

**WHEREAS there has been established in Trinidad and Tobago an organisation known as the Sri Sathya Sai  
Baba Organisation of Trinidad and Tobago:** Preamble

And whereas it is expedient that the Sri Sathya Sai Baba Organisation of Trinidad and Tobago be incorporated for the purposes hereinafter set forth:

Enactment	ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as follows:—
Short title	1. This Act may be cited as the Sri Sathya Sai Baba Organisation of Trinidad and Tobago (Incorporation) Act, 1993.
Incorporation	2. The Sri Sathya Sai Baba Organisation of Trinidad and Tobago (hereinafter called “the Organisation”) is hereby created a body corporate.
Aims and objects	<p>3. The aims and objects of the Organisation are—</p> <p>(a) by a process of spiritual discipline to help the individual:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) to become aware of the Divinity inherent in him and to conduct himself accordingly;</li> <li>(ii) to translate into practice in his daily life the spiritual values of truth, righteous conduct, peace, love and non-violence; and</li> <li>(iii) to fill his life with joy, harmony, beauty, grace, human excellence and lasting happiness;</li> </ul> <p>(b) to bring about the spiritual transformation of humanity by the propagation and practice of the teachings of Bhagavan Sri Sathya Sai Baba;</p> <p>(c) to do all such other lawful things as are necessary, incidental or conducive to the attainment of any of the above objects.</p>
Powers of the Organisation	<p>4. The Organisation shall have power—</p> <p>(a) to acquire by purchase, transfer, donation, exchange, devise, bequest, grant, gift,</p>

conveyance or howsoever otherwise, any real or personal property or any estate or interest therein;

- (b) to accept surrenders or reconveyance and to enter into contracts;
- (c) to sell, exchange, demise, mortgage or otherwise dispose of and deal with all property which may for the time being be vested in it, subject to any restraint, reservation or condition contained in the document under which it has acquired title.

5. All real or personal property now held by or vested in any person for the use and benefit of the Organisation, is hereby transferred to and vested in the Organisation.

Transfer and vesting of property

6. All documents requiring the seal of the Organisation shall be sealed with the common seal of the Organisation in the presence of the Chairman and the Secretary for the time being in office or in the event of incapacity or absence from the territory, in the presence of some other person or persons authorised for that purpose by the Organisation who shall both sign every such document and such signing shall be *prima facie* evidence that the said seal was duly affixed and that the same is the lawful seal of the Organisation.

Mode of execution of documents

7. (1) The Organisation shall at all times have a fixed address in Trinidad and Tobago for the service of documents on the Organisation and that address and any change thereof shall be registered with the Registrar General within twenty-eight days of the date of incorporation or the change of address as the case may be.

Service of documents

(2) Every document to be served on the Organisation may be served by leaving the same at, or by sending the same by registered post to the registered address of the Organisation.

(3) Failure to register the address and any change thereof is a summary offence and renders the Organisation liable to a fine of one hundred and twenty dollars and to a further fine of ten dollars for each day during which the offence continues after conviction therefor.

Power to make rules

8. The Organisation may from time to time make rules for the proper conduct of its proceedings and discharge of its duties, powers and functions and may amend such rules.

Saving of State and other rights

9. Nothing in this Act shall affect or be deemed to affect the rights of the State, or of any bodies politic or corporate or of any persons, except such as are mentioned or referred to in this Act and those claiming by, through, from or under them.
