**REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO**

**Act No. 32 of 1991**

AN ACT to provide for the payment of pension and compensation for loss of office to Richard James and Preston Zamore, former members of the Defence Force.

*[Assented to 12th November, 1991]*

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago Enactment  
as follows:—

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the James and Zamore (Compensation for Loss of Office and Payment of Pensions) Act, 1991.

Authority to pay gratuity and pension to Richard James and Preston Zamore

2. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, there shall be paid out of the Consolidated Fund to Richard James and Preston Zamore as pension and compensation for loss of office as members of the Defence Force, the following payments as if regulations 9 and 10 of the Defence (Pay and Superannuation) (Transferred Officers) Regulations, 1967 were applicable to them—

(a) to Richard James as follows—

- (i) as compensation for loss of office, the sum of eight thousand, seven hundred and seventy-one dollars and seventy-six cents;
- (ii) as a gratuity, the sum of one thousand, eight hundred and twelve dollars and fifteen cents;
- (iii) as pensions, the sum of four hundred and thirty-four dollars and ninety-two cents per annum;
- (iv) appropriate increments to pensions at subparagraph (iii) as have been accorded to similar categories of pensioners with effect from 11th October, 1968 and continuing;
- (v) appropriate Cost of Living Allowance as has been accorded to similar categories of pensioners with effect from 11th October, 1968 and continuing;

(b) to Preston Zamore as follows—

- (i) as compensation for loss of office, the sum of fifteen thousand, one hundred and seventy-two dollars and thirty-two cents;
- (ii) as a gratuity, the sum of six thousand one hundred and ninety-five dollars;
- (iii) as pensions, the sum of one thousand, four hundred and eighty-six dollars and eighty cents per annum;

- (iv) appropriate increments to pensions at subparagraph (iii) as have been accorded to similar categories of pensioners with effect from 1st February, 1970 and continuing;
- (v) appropriate Cost of Living Allowance as has been accorded to similar categories of pensioners with effect from 1st February, 1970 and continuing.
