**AN ACT for the incorporation of The Lions Club of
Chaguanas and for matters incidental thereto**

[Assented to 9th September, 1991]

WHEREAS there has been established in Trinidad and ^{Preamble}
Tobago an organisation known as the Lions Club of
Chaguanas.

And whereas it is expedient that the Lions Club of Chaguanas be incorporated:

- Enactment** ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as follows:—
- Short title** 1. This Act may be cited as The Lions Club of Chaguanas (Incorporation) Act, 1991.
- Incorporation** 2. The Lions Club of Chaguanas (hereinafter called “the Club”) is hereby created a body corporate.
- Aims and objects** 3. The aims and objects of the Club are—
- (a) to create and foster a spirit of understanding among the peoples of the world;
 - (b) to promote the principles of good government and good citizenship;
 - (c) to take an active interest in the civic, cultural, social and moral welfare of the community;
 - (d) to provide a forum for the open discussion of all matters of public interest, provided however, that partisan politics and sectarian religion shall not be debated by Club members;
 - (e) to encourage service-minded men to serve their community without personal financial reward, and to encourage efficiency and promote high ethical standards in commerce, industry, professions, public works and private endeavours;
 - (f) to do all such other things as are necessary, incidental or conducive to the attainment of the above-mentioned objects.
- Powers of the club** 4. The Club shall have power—
- (a) to acquire by purchase, transfer, donation, exchange, devise, bequest, grant, gift, conveyance or howsoever otherwise, any real or personal property or any estate or interest therein;
 - (b) to accept surrenders or reconveyances and to enter into contracts;

- (c) to sell, exchange, demise, mortgage or otherwise dispose of and deal with any property which may for the time being be vested in or acquired by the Club subject to any restraint, reservation or condition contained in any document under which the club has acquired title thereto;
- (d) to do all such things that may be appropriate to its aims and objects.

5. All real or personal property now held by or vested in any person for the use and benefit of the Club, is hereby transferred to and vested in the Club. Transfer and vesting of property

6. All documents requiring the seal of the Club shall be sealed with its common seal in the presence of the President and Secretary for the time being in office or, in the event of incapacity in the presence of some other person or persons authorized for that purpose by the Club who shall both sign every such document and such signing shall be *prima facie* evidence that the said seal was duly affixed and that the same is the lawful seal of the Club. Mode of execution of documents

7. (1) The Club shall at all times have a fixed address in Trinidad and Tobago for the service of documents on it and that address and any change thereof shall be registered with the Registrar General within twenty-eight days of the date of incorporation or the change of address as the case may be. Service of documents

(2) Every document to be served on the Club may be served by leaving the same at, or by sending the same by registered post to, the registered address of the Club.

(3) Failure to register the address and any change thereof is a summary offence and renders the Club liable to a fine of one hundred and twenty dollars and to a further fine of ten dollars for each day during which the offence continues after conviction therefor.

8. The Club may from time to time make rules for the proper conduct of its proceedings and discharge of its duties, powers and functions and may amend such rules. Power to make rules

Saving of state
and other rights

9. Nothing in this Act shall affect or be deemed to affect the rights of the State, or of any bodies politic or corporate or of any person, except such as are mentioned or referred to in this Act and those claiming by, through, from or under them.
