IMPORTATION) ACT, CHAP. 67:02

THE VAMPIRE BAT TRANSMITTED PARALYTIC RABIES
(INFECTED AREA) ORDER, 1997

1. This Order may be cited as the Vampire Bat Transmitted ^{Citation}
Paralytic Rabies (Infected Area) Order, 1997.

2. The following areas are declared to be infected or suspected of
being infected with Vampire Bat Transmitted Paralytic Rabies:

- (a) Waller Field, situated in the Ward of Arima in the County
of St. George;
- (b) Valencia, situated in the Ward of Turre in the County of
St. Andrew; and
- (a) Fishing Pond, situated in the Ward of Manzanilla in the
County of St. Andrew.

3. In respect of the areas listed in paragraph 2, it shall be
unlawful to—

- (a) move any animal into or out of the areas except in the
manner prescribed by the Inspector in writing; and
- (b) allow any animal to come into contact with any animal
infected with, or suspected of being infected with, Vampire
Bat Transmitted Paralytic Rabies.
