OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)
(CALYPSO FIESTA) AND (SOUTH STEELBAND PANORAMA)
ORDER, 1994

- Citation** 1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Provisions) (Calypso Fiesta) and (South Steelband Panorama) Order, 1994.
- Commencement and cessation** 2. This Order has effect on the dates and between the times specified hereunder—
(a) 10.00 a.m. to 10.00 p.m. on Saturday, 5th February, 1994;
(b) 10.00 a.m. to 12.00 midnight on Sunday, 6th February, 1994.
- Parking restricted** 3. Vehicles may be parked on the following roads:
(a) Princess Margaret Street—on the western side only;
(b) Rambaransingh Street—on the northern side only;
(c) Turton Street—on the western side only;
(d) Prince Charles Street—on the southern side only.
- Route to Skinner Park** 4. Vehicles conveying steelbands to Skinner Park shall proceed West only along Park Street.
- Roads closed** 5. The following streets shall be closed to vehicular traffic:
(a) Ciperio Street, between Donaldson Street and Rienzi-Kirton Highway;
(b) Todd Street, between Scrimgeour Street and Rienzi-Kirton Highway;
(c) Park Street, between Ciperio Street and Todd Street;
(d) Scott Street, between Ciperio Street and Richards Street.
- One-way traffic** 6. Motorists using Shah Street shall proceed in a northerly direction only.
- Two-way traffic** 7. Vehicles proceeding along Rienzi-Kirton Highway shall proceed in both directions along the West bound lane.
- Removal and impounding of vehicles unlawfully parked Chap. 48:50** 8. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
