ORDER

MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1) OF THE
MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)
(REPUBLIC DAY CARNIVAL KINGS AND QUEENS OF THE
WORLD STREET PARADE) ORDER, 1994

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary ^{Citation} Provisions) (Republic Day Carnival Kings and Queens of the World Street Parade) Order, 1994.

2. This Order has effect between the hours of 12.00 midday and ^{Duration} 8.00 p.m. on Saturday, 24th September, 1994.

3. The following roads shall be closed to vehicular traffic during ^{Roads closed} the specified times:

- (a) Frederick Street, between Queen's Park West and Park Street from 12.00 midday to 3.00 p.m.;
- (b) Park Street, between Frederick Street and Flament Street from 2.00 p.m. to 4.00 p.m.;
- (c) Ariapita Avenue, between Flament Street and Belle Smythe Street from 2.00 p.m. to 5.00 p.m.

4. Parking is prohibited on the following roads:

- (a) Frederick Street, between Queen's Park West and Duke Street;
- (b) Park Street, between Frederick Street and Flament Street;
- (c) Ariapita Avenue, between Flament Street and Belle Smythe Street;
- (d) Maraval Parkway;
- (e) Fitz Blackman Drive;
- (f) Wrightson Road Extension;
- (g) Mucurapo Link Road;
- (h) Hamilton Holder Street;
- (i) Dennis Mahabir Street.

5. Motorists shall proceed as follows:

- (a) in an easterly direction only on Wrightson Road Extension, between Fitz Blackman Drive and Ana Street;
- (b) on Fitz Blackman Drive, between Maraval Parkway and Wrightson Road Extension—
 - (i) in a southerly direction only from 12.00 midday to 6.00 p.m.;
 - (ii) in a northerly direction only from 6.00 p.m. to 8.00 p.m.

No right turn

6. Motorist proceeding south along Dennis Mahabir Street shall not turn right into Wrightson Road Extension.

7. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
