ORDER

MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1) OF THE  
MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE UNION PARK RACES (CALYPSO MEETING) (TEMPORARY  
PROVISIONS) ORDER, 1991

1. This Order may be cited as the Union Park Races (Calypso Meeting) <sup>Citation</sup>  
(Temporary Provisions) Order, 1991.

2. This Order comes into operation at 10.00 a.m. and ceases at 7.00 p.m. <sup>Duration</sup>  
on each of the undermentioned dates:

- Saturday, 16th February, 1991;
- Saturday, 23rd February, 1991;
- Saturday, 2nd March, 1991;
- Saturday, 9th March, 1991;
- Saturday, 23rd March, 1991;
- Saturday, 30th March, 1991;
- Monday, 1st April, 1991;
- Saturday, 6th April, 1991;
- Saturday, 13th April, 1991;
- Saturday, 20th April, 1991.

3. No person shall park or cause or permit any vehicle to be parked or to <sup>Parking</sup>  
remain on— <sup>prohibited</sup>  
<sup>on certain</sup>  
<sup>roads</sup>

- (a) Guaracara-Tabaquite Road between the Southern Main Road and  
Battoo Avenue;
- (b) Union Road; and
- (c) the roads to Gopaul Lands.

4. Parking on Union Park shall be as follows:

- (a) committee members and stewards—on spaces immediately North <sup>Special</sup>  
and South of the main entrance to the stand; <sup>parking</sup>
- (b) members of the New Union Park Race Club—West of the paddock  
and on the northern side of Guaracara-Tabaquite Road and  
Harmony Hall Road.

5. Between 5.00 p.m. and 7.00 p.m. on the dates specified in paragraph 2, <sup>One-way</sup>  
drivers travelling along the Guaracara-Tabaquite Road between the Southern <sup>traffic</sup>  
Main Road and Union Road shall proceed in an easterly direction only.

6. Between 10.00 a.m. and 5.00 p.m. on the dates specified in paragraph 2, drivers approaching Union Park from a southerly direction shall proceed along Gopaul Lands.

7. Between 5.00 p.m. and 7.00 p.m. on the dates specified in paragraph 2, drivers leaving Union Park shall proceed in a westerly direction along Gopaul Lands.

8. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
