ORDER

MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1) OF THE
MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)
(INDEPENDENCE SQUARE) ORDER, 1993

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Citation Provisions) (Independence Square) Order, 1993.

2. This Order comes into operation at 6.00 a.m. on Monday, 1st February, 1993 and ceases at 6.00 a.m. on Tuesday, 2nd March, 1993.

3. Parking is prohibited on the following roads:

Parking
prohibited

- (a) Independence Square North, between Frederick Street and George Street;
- (b) Independence Square South, between George Street and Broadway.

4. Taxis shall operate as follows:

Temporary
taxi-stand

- (a) Broadway taxis plying for hire from the eastern side and western side of Cipriani Circle shall ply for hire from the northern side of Independence Square South, between Broadway and Chacon Street;
- (b) Chaguanas "round the road" taxis plying for hire from the southern side of Independence Square North, between Charlotte Street and George Street shall ply for hire from the northern side of Independence Square North, from a point five metres West of George Street to a point five metres East of Charlotte Street;
- (c) San Fernando/Chaguanas Highway maxi-taxis plying for hire from the southern side of Independence Square South, between Henry Street and Charlotte Street shall ply for hire from the northern side of South Quay, from a point five metres West of George Street to a point five metres East of Henry Street;
- (d) San Fernando/Chaguanas taxis plying for hire from the southern side of Independence Square North, between Henry Street and Charlotte Street shall ply for hire from the northern side of Independence Square North, from a point five metres West of Charlotte Street to a point five metres East of Henry Street;
- (e) Arima/Sangre Grande taxis plying for hire from the northern side of Independence Square South, between Broadway and Henry Street shall ply for hire on the western side of lower Henry Street facing South, from a point five metres North of South Quay to a point five metres South of Independence Square South;

- (f) Tunapuna/Curepe taxis plying for hire from the southern side of Independence Square North, between Cipriani Circle and Henry Street, shall ply for hire on the eastern side of lower Henry Street facing South, from a point five metres North of South Quay to a point five metres South of Independence Square South;
- (g) San Juan taxis plying for hire from the southern side of Independence Square South, between Charlotte Street and George Street, shall ply for hire from the western side of George Street, from a point five metres South of Independence Square South to a point five metres North of South Quay; and
- (h) Eastern Main Road (Red Band) maxi-taxis plying for hire from the western side of Charlotte Street, between Independence Square South and South Quay facing North, shall ply for hire within the same area, from a point five metres South of Independence Square South to a point five metres North of South Quay facing South.

Traffic directional change

5. Vehicular traffic that normally proceeds North on Charlotte Street between South Quay and Independence Square South shall now proceed in a southerly direction only.

Vehicular traffic permitted

6. Vehicular traffic is permitted to travel North along George Street between Independence Square South and Independence Square North.

No entry to maxi-taxis

7. Maxi-taxis proceeding West along Independence Square South shall not turn right at George Street and will be diverted South along Charlotte Street.

Vehicular traffic prohibited

8. Vehicular traffic is prohibited on Charlotte Street between Independence Square North and South.

Removal and impounding of vehicles unlawfully parked

9. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
