MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1)
OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)
(STEELBAND PANORAMA) ORDER, 1993

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Provisions) (Steelband Panorama) Order, 1993.

Commencement and cessation

2. This Order has effect on the dates and between the times specified hereunder:

- (a) 10.00 a.m. on Saturday, 6th February, 1993 and 4.00 a.m. on Sunday, 7th February, 1993;
- (b) 8.00 a.m. on Sunday, 7th February, 1993 and 4.00 a.m. on Monday, 8th February, 1993;
- (c) 5.00 p.m. on Friday, 12th February, 1993 and 4.00 a.m. on Saturday, 13th February, 1993;
- (d) 5.00 p.m. on Thursday, 18th February, 1993 and 4.00 a.m. on Friday, 19th February, 1993; and
- (e) 5.00 p.m. on Saturday, 20th February, 1993 and 4.00 a.m. on Sunday, 21st February, 1993.

Parking prohibited

3. During the times and on the dates specified in paragraph 2, no person shall park or cause or permit any vehicle to be parked or to remain on any of the roads mentioned below:

- (a) Queen's Park West, except for taxis at the Princes Building Taxi Stand;
- (b) Chancery Lane;
- (c) Albion Street, between Victoria Avenue and Chancery Lane;
- (d) Pembroke Street, between Keate Street and Gordon Street;
- (e) Frederick Street, between Queen's Park West and Gordon Street;
- (f) Keate Street;
- (g) Queen's Park East, between Jerningham Avenue and Queen's Park West;
- (h) Charlotte Street, between Queen's Park West and New Street;
- (i) Gordon Street, between Charlotte Street and Dundonald Street;
- (j) Victoria Avenue, between Queen's Park West and Albion Street, except for taxis at the Queen's Park Taxi Stand;
- (k) Dundonald Street, between Gordon Street and Queen's Park West.

4. Parking of motor vehicles is restricted on the following roads: **Parking restricted**
- (a) on Stanmore Avenue, between Queen's Park West and Tranquillity Street—to the western side;
 - (b) on Victoria Avenue, between Albion Street and Tragarete Road—to the eastern side;
 - (c) on Dere Street, between Cummins Lane and Melville Lane—to the western side.

5. Vehicular traffic shall proceed— **One-way traffic**
- (a) on Keate Street, between Charlotte Street, and Chancery Lane—in a westerly direction only;
 - (b) on Chancery Lane, between Keate Street and Queen's Park West—in a northerly direction only;
 - (c) on Albion Street—in a westerly direction only.

6. Vehicular traffic may proceed in both directions along Gordon Street, **Two-way traffic** between Chancery Lane and Frederick Street.

7. The roads listed hereunder are closed to vehicular traffic: **Roads closed**
- (a) Frederick Street, between Keate Street and Queen's Park West; and
 - (b) Queen's Park West, between Queen's Park East and Frederick Street.

8. Vehicular traffic is prohibited along Queen's Park West, between Frederick Street and Chancery Lane, except for vehicles conveying steelband instruments. **Traffic prohibited**

9. Vehicles may be parked in the Queen's Park Savannah in accordance with the directions of police officers on duty. **Parking—Queen's Park Savannah**

10. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act. **Removal and impounding of vehicles unlawfully parked Chap. 48:50**
