MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1) OF
THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS) (PAN-
AROUND-THE-NECK AND SMALL BANDS PANORAMA FINALS)
ORDER, 1993

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Provisions) (Pan-around-the-neck and Small Bands Panorama Finals) Order, 1993. Citation

2. This Order has effect between the hours of 5.00 p.m. on Friday, 19th February, 1993 and 2.00 a.m. on Saturday, 20th February, 1993. Duration

3. Vehicular traffic, with the exception of vehicles conveying Steel Pans is prohibited on the following roads: Vehicular traffic prohibited

- (a) Independence Square North, between Wrightson Road and Nelson Street;
- (b) Charlotte Street, between Queen Street and Independence Square North;
- (c) Frederick Street, between Queen Street and Independence Square North;
- (d) Chacon Street, between Queen Street and Independence Square North;
- (e) St. Vincent Street, between Queen Street and Independence Square North;
- (f) Edward Street, between Independence Square South and Independence Square North;
- (g) Abercromby Street, between Independence Square South and Independence Square North; and
- (h) the eastern and western sides of Cipriani Circle.

4. Vehicular traffic is permitted in a southerly direction only on Richmond Street, between Independence Square North and Independence Square South. Through traffic

5. Parking is prohibited on Independence Square North, between Wrightson Road and George Street. Parking prohibited

6. Taxis shall operate as follows:

- (a) taxis assigned to taxi stands on Independence Square North, between St. Vincent Street and Abercromby Street, shall operate from the eastern side of Chacon Street, between Independence Square South and South Quay; and Taxi stands
- (b) taxis assigned to taxi stands on Independence Square North, other than those referred to in subparagraph (a), shall operate from the northern side of South Quay, between Abercromby Street and Henry Street.

7. Vehicles conveying Steel Pans are permitted to park on the following roads:

- (a) on the eastern side of George Street, between Independence Square North and Queen Street;
- (b) on the eastern side of Charlotte Street, between Queen Street and Independence Square North;
- (c) on the eastern side of Henry Street, between Independence Square North and Queen Street.

8. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order, may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
