ORDER

MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1) OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS) (MARACAS, ST. JOSEPH) ORDER, 1993

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Citation Provisions) (Maracas, St. Joseph) Order, 1993.
2. This Order comes into operation on Wednesday, 26th May, 1993 and ceases at 12.00 midnight on Friday, 25th June, 1993. Commencement and cessation
3. Stopping, waiting or parking, is prohibited on Riverside Road, between Gordon Street and Maracas Royal Road, between the hours of 6.00 a.m. and 9.00 a.m. and 2.30 p.m. and 6.30 p.m. from Monday to Saturday. Stopping, waiting, parking, prohibited
4. Motorists approaching— Alternative routes
 - (a) St. Joseph, Curepe along Eastern Main Road from Maracas, St. Joseph via Maracas Royal Road shall do so by way of Riverside Road;
 - (b) Maracas, St. Joseph shall proceed North along Riverside Road to Maracas Royal Road.
5. Vehicular traffic proceeding North along Riverside Road, Curepe shall not turn left onto Maracas Royal Road (St. Joseph Bridge No. 1). No left turn
6. Vehicular traffic proceeding South along Riverside Road, Curepe shall not turn right onto Maracas Royal Road (St. Joseph Bridge No. 1). No right turn
7. A person who contravenes any of the provisions of this Order is guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of one hundred and fifty dollars. Offence
8. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act. Removal and impounding of vehicles unlawfully parked
