REGULATIONS

MADE BY THE PRESIDENT UNDER SECTION 15 OF THE PLANT
PROTECTION ORDINANCE

THE PLANT PROTECTION (TEMPORARY) REGULATIONS, 1987

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Plant Protection Citation
(Temporary) Regulations, 1987, and shall be read and construed as
one with the Plant Protection Regulations.

2. These Regulations shall remain in force until the Minister by Duration
Notice published in the *Gazette* declares that he is satisfied that the
threat of pest infestation of the mango seed weevil is over.

3. During the period that these Regulations remain in force Importation
of mangoes
prohibited
no mangoes shall be imported into Trinidad and Tobago except under
and in accordance with a permit issued by the Chief Technical
Officer in the Ministry of Food Production, Marine Exploitation,
Forestry and the Environment.
