ORDER

MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1) OF THE  
MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)  
(PRESIDENT'S AWARD CEREMONY) ORDER, 2019

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Citation Provisions) (President's Award Ceremony) Order, 2019.

2. This Order has effect from 2.00 p.m. to 11.00 p.m. on Tuesday Duration 24th September, 2019.

3. A driver of a motor vehicle shall not park along—

Parking prohibited

- (a) Queen's Park West, between Queen's Park East and Dundonald Street;
- (b) Keate Street, between Charlotte Street and Chancery Lane;
- (c) Gordon Street, between Charlotte Street and Dundonald Street;
- (d) Frederick Street, between Gordon Street and Queen's Park West;
- (e) Abercromby Street, between Gordon Street and Keate Street;
- (f) Pembroke Street, between Gordon Street and Keate Street; and
- (g) Chancery Lane.

4. A driver of a motor vehicle shall not proceed on—

Road closed

- (a) Frederick Street, between Queen's Park West and Gordon Street;
- (b) Keate Street, between Charlotte Street and Chancery Lane; and
- (c) Pembroke Street, between Gordon Street and Keate Street.

Vehicular

5. A driver of a motor vehicle proceeding—

(a) north on Charlotte Street, may turn west onto Gordon Street; and

(b) north on Henry Street, shall turn west onto Gordon Street.

Removal and  
impounding  
of vehicles  
unlawfully  
parked

6. Without prejudice to any liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
