## A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it is provided by section 30(1) of the Representation of the People Act, Chap. 2:01, (hereinafter referred to as “the Act”) that for the purposes of an election, the President may, by Proclamation, published in the *Trinidad and Tobago Gazette*, direct that an electoral registration shall be conducted in the Registration Area Offices or the Temporary Registration Area Offices established in the electoral district in which such election is to be held:

Now, therefore, I, PAULA-MAE WEEKES, President as aforesaid, do hereby direct that an electoral registration shall be conducted in each of the undermentioned electoral districts defined in the Schedule to the Elections and Boundaries Commission (Local Government and Tobago House of Assembly) Order, 2019, in relation to the electoral area of the Borough of Arima for the purpose of the election of a Councillor to serve on the Municipal Council of the Borough of Arima and I hereby fix the 24th day of October, 2019, as the date of the commencement of the Electoral Registration.

The electoral districts to which this Proclamation relates are—

1. Arima Central;
2. Arima North-east;
3. Arima West/O'Meara;
4. Calvary;
5. Malabar North;
6. Malabar South; and
7. Tumpuna.
