WORKERS' BANK (1989) LIMITED SUPPLEMENTAL

| Stamp duty exemption | 2. No stamp duty shall be payable upon the transfer and vesting in the Transferee Bank, of all the estate and interest of the Transferor Bank in the properties. |
| Commencement | 3. This Order shall come into force on the 12th day of September, 1993. |

SCHEDULE

(a) Leasehold hereditaments and premises situate in the City of Port-of-Spain, Trinidad having frontage of Sixty Three Point Nine Feet on Independence Square (formerly Marine Square) and 53 feet on Duncan Street and abutting on the North and East upon lands of the National Housing Authority, on the South upon Independence Square and on the West upon Duncan Street and which said piece or parcel of land is delineated and coloured pink on the plan or diagram marked "A" and annexed to a Lease dated the 2nd day of August, 1945 and registered as No. 5837 of 1945 and which premises are known and assessed as No. 8 Independence Square, Port-of-Spain.

(b) Freehold hereditaments and premises situate in the City of Port-of-Spain formerly known as No. 96 Queen Street but since renumbered and known as No. 6 Queen Street and bounded on the North by lands now or lately of Charles Waidlieu, on the South by Queen Street, on the East by No. 4 Queen Street and on the West by No. 8 Queen Street together with the buildings thereon and the appurtenances thereto belonging.
