THE IMMIGRATION (RESTRICTION) ORDINANCE, CH. 20. No. 2  
THE IMMIGRATION (RESTRICTION) (CLASSES OF UNDESIRABLE  
IMMIGRANTS) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1955

MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL UNDER SECTION 4 (1) (g) OF THE  
IMMIGRATION (RESTRICTION) ORDINANCE

IN exercise of the powers conferred on the Governor in Council by paragraph (g) of subsection (1) of section 4 of the Immigration (Restriction) Ordinance, the following Order is hereby made :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Immigration (Restriction) (Classes of Undesirable Immigrants) (Amendment) Order, 1955, and shall be read as one with the Immigration (Restriction) (Classes of Undesirable Immigrants) Order, 1953, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Order.

2. The Schedule to the Principal Order is hereby amended by deleting therefrom the following :—
