A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it is provided by section 30(1) of the Representation of the People Act, Chap. 2:01 (hereinafter referred to as “the Act”), that for the purposes of an election, the President may, by Proclamation, published in the *Trinidad and Tobago Gazette*, direct that an electoral registration shall be conducted in the Registration Area Offices or the Temporary Registration Area Offices established in the electoral district in which such election is to be held:

And whereas it is further provided by section 30(3) of the Act that the President may, by a subsequent Proclamation, published in the *Trinidad and Tobago Gazette*, fix the date of the termination of an electoral registration:

And whereas, by Proclamation dated the 20th day of June, 2023, it was directed that an electoral registration be conducted in the electoral area of San Juan/Laventille, as defined in the Schedule to the Elections and Boundaries Commission (Local Government and Tobago House of Assembly) Order, 2023, in relation to the electoral area of San Juan/Laventille for the purpose of the election of a Councillor to serve on the Municipal Council of San Juan/Laventille and the 20th day of June, 2023, was fixed as the date of the commencement of the electoral registration:

Now, therefore, I, **CHRISTINE CARLA KANGALOO**, President as aforesaid, do hereby fix the 12th day of September, 2023, as the date of termination of the electoral registration in the electoral area of San Juan/Laventille, as defined in the Schedule to the Elections and Boundaries Commission (Local Government and Tobago House of Assembly) Order, 2023.

The electoral districts to which this Proclamation relates are—

1. Aranguez/Warner Village;
2. Barataria;
3. Beetham/Picton;
4. Caledonia/Upper Malick;
5. El Socorro/Aranguez North;
6. Febeau/Bourg Mulatresse;
7. Maracas Bay/Santa Cruz/La Fillette;
8. Morvant;
9. Petit Bourg/Mount Lambert/Champs Fleurs;
10. San Juan East;
11. San Juan West;
12. St. Ann's/Cascade/Mon Repos West;
13. St. Barbs/Chinapoo; and
14. Success/Trou Macaque.
