MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1) OF
THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)
(INDEPENDENCE SQUARE) ORDER, 1982

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Provisions) (Independence Square) Order, 1982. Citation
2. This Order comes into operation at 6.00 a.m. on Saturday, 9th January, 1982 and ceases at 6.00 p.m. on Tuesday, 9th February, 1982. Commence-
ment and
cessation
3. Vehicular traffic is restricted to the northern half of Independence Square North, between Frederick Street and Henry Street, and to the southern half of Independence Square South, between Henry Street and Broadway. Traffic
restriction
4. No person may park or cause or permit any vehicle to be parked or to remain on any of the following roads:— Parking
prohibited
 - (a) Independence Square North, between Frederick Street and Henry Street; and
 - (b) Independence Square South, between Charlotte Street and Broadway—on the northern half only.
5. Taxis that normally use the Taxi Stand on the northern side of Independence Square South between Henry Street and Broadway, shall use the northern half of Independence Square South between Charlotte Street and Henry Street. Temporary
Taxi Stand
6. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act. Removal
