THE UNION PARK RACES (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS) ORDER,
1982

1. This Order may be cited as the Union Park Races (Temporary Provisions) Order, 1982. Citation

2. This Order comes into operation at 10.00 a.m. and ceases at 7.00 p.m. on the days listed below:— Commence-
ment

23rd January, 1982

30th January, 1982

6th February, 1982

13th February, 1982

27th February, 1982

6th March, 1982

13th March, 1982

20th March, 1982.

3. No person shall park any vehicle on the roads listed below:— Parking
prohibited
on certain
roads

(a) Guaracara-Tabaquite Road between the Southern Main Road and Battoo Avenue;

(b) Union Road;

(c) the roads of Gopaul Lands.

4. Parking on Union Park shall be as follows:—

(a) Committee and Stewards of the New Union Park Race Club —On spaces immediately North and South of the Main Entrance to the Stand; Special
Parking

(b) Members of the New Union Park Race Club —West of the stand;

(c) General Public —West of the paddock and on the northern side of Guaracara-Tabaquite Road and Harmony Hall Road.

5. Between 5.00 p.m. and 7.00 p.m. on the days listed in paragraph 2, vehicles travelling along the Guaracara-Tabaquite Road between Southern Main Road and Union Road shall proceed in an easterly direction only. One-Way

6. Between 10.00 a.m. and 5.00 p.m. on the days listed in paragraph 2, vehicles approaching Union Park from a southerly direction shall proceed along Gopaul Road.

7. Between 5.00 p.m. and 7.00 p.m. on the days listed in paragraph 2, vehicles leaving Union Park shall proceed in a westerly direction along Gopaul Road.

8. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(a) or (b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
