ORDER

MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1) OF THE  
MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)  
(EAST STEELBAND PANORAMA) ORDER, 1982

**Citation** 1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Provisions) (East Steelband Panorama) Order, 1982.

**Commencement and cessation** 2. This Order shall be effective on the dates and times specified below:—

Friday, 5th February, 1982—from 6.00 p.m. to 12.00 midnight;  
Saturday, 13th February, 1982—from 5.00 p.m. to 12.00 midnight.

**Streets closed** 3. During the dates and on the times specified in paragraph 2, the following roads are closed to vehicular traffic, and parking is prohibited thereon:—

- (a) Queen Street, between Farfan Street and Hollis Avenue;
- (b) Pro. Queen Street, between Hollis Avenue and Robinson Circular;
- (c) Hollis Avenue, between St. Joseph and Queen Streets.

**Parking prohibited** 4. During the dates and on the times specified in paragraph 2, parking is prohibited on the following roads:—

- (a) Farfan Street, between Queen and King Streets;
- (b) King Street, between Hollis Avenue and Green Street;
- (c) Queen Mary Avenue;
- (d) Robinson Circular.

**Vehicular routes** 5. During the dates and on the times specified in paragraph 2, traffic approaching Arima will do so as follows:—

- (a) From the West—along the Eastern Main Road, North into St. Joseph Street and East along Broadway;
- (b) From the East—South along Queen Street, West along Farfan Street, South along King Street, West along Anglican Street and South along Industry Street;
- (c) From the South—East into Quesnel Street, North along Cocorite Road and West along Broadway.

6. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order, may be removed by the police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
