MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)
(STEELBAND PANORAMA) ORDER, 1982

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Provisions) (Steelband Panorama) Order, 1982.

Commence-
ment and
cessation

2. This Order has effect on the dates and times specified below—
- Saturday, 6th February—from 6.00 a.m. to 12.00 midnight;
 - Friday, 12th February—from 5.00 p.m. to 12.00 midnight;
 - Thursday, 18th February—from 5.00 p.m. to 12.00 midnight;
 - Saturday, 20th February—from 5.00 p.m. to 12.00 midnight.

Parking
prohibited

3. During the dates and on the times specified in paragraph 2, no person shall park any vehicle on the roads listed below—

- (a) Queen's Park West except for taxis plying for hire in the Taxi Stands;
- (b) Chancery Lane;
- (c) Albion Street between Victoria Avenue and Chancery Lane;
- (d) Pembroke Street between New Street and Keate Street;
- (e) Frederick Street between New Street and Queen's Park West;
- (f) Keate Street;
- (g) Queen's Park East between Jerningham Avenue and Queen's Park West;
- (h) Charlotte Street between Queen's Park West and New Street;
- (i) Cipriani Boulevard—on the eastern side only except for trucks conveying steelband instruments;
- (j) Gordon Street between Charlotte Street and Dundonald Street;
- (k) Victoria Avenue between Queen's Park West and Albion Street except for taxis plying for hire on the Queen's Park Taxi Stand; and
- (l) Dundonald Street between Gordon Street and Queen's Park West.

4. During the times and on the dates specified in paragraph 2, parking is restricted on the roads listed below as follows—
Parking restricted

- (a) Stanmore Avenue between Queen's Park West and Tranquillity Street—on the western side only;
- (b) Dundonald Street between Gordon Street and Tragarete Road—on the eastern side only;
- (c) Victoria Avenue between Albion Street and Tragarete Road—on the eastern side only; and
- (d) Dere Street between Cummins Lane and Melville Lane—on the western side only.

5. During the times and on the dates shown in paragraph 2, vehicular traffic shall proceed as indicated below—
One-Way traffic

- (a) Keate Street between Charlotte Street and Chancery Lane—in a westerly direction only;
- (b) Chancery Lane between Keate Street and Queen's Park West—in a northerly direction only;
- (c) Albion Street—in an easterly direction only.

6. The following roads are closed to vehicular traffic—
Roads closed

- (a) Frederick Street between Keate Street and Queen's Park West; and
- (b) Queen's Park West between Queen's Park East and Frederick Street.

7. Only vehicles conveying steelband instruments and taxis plying for hire from Princes Building Taxi Stand are allowed to travel along Queen's Park West, between Chancery Lane and Frederick Street.
Traffic restricted

8. Notwithstanding any other enactment to the contrary parking on the Queen's Park Savannah shall be in accordance with the directions of the Police Officers on duty as follows—
Parking of vehicles on Queen's Park Savannah

- (a) on Saturday, 6th February, 1982—from 6.00 a.m. to 12.00 midnight;
- (b) on Friday, 12th February, 1982—from 5.00 p.m. to 12.00 midnight;
- (c) on Thursday, 18th February, 1982—from 5.00 p.m. to 12.00 midnight;
- (d) on Saturday, 20th February, 1982—from 5.00 p.m. to 12.00 midnight.

9. Without prejudice to any liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
